

"TONIGHT'S THE NIGHT" BACKLINE REQUIREMENTS

The Keyboard rig is controlled by a Macbook Pro Laptop and MainStage
(Keyboardist will bring laptop)

Note: If an 88 key with built-in A/D converter is NOT available such as the keyboards listed below or similar, then 1/8" stereo jack to 1/4" pair will be needed for the Laptop.

Keyboard 1:

- 88 key weighted USB controller pref with built-in A/D converter - Roland RD-88, Arturia Keylab 88 mkII, or Yamaha MoXF8
- Proline Sustain Pedal
- m-Audio Expression pedal

Keyboard 2:

- Arturia Keylab 61 Mk II
- Yamaha foot pedal
- m-Audio Expression pedal
- Boss FS7 Dual Foot Switch (for MainStage patch changes)
- Boss FS5U Foot Switch (for MainStage parameter changes)

Keyboard Stand:

- Apex AX-48 2 tier Keyboard Stand

Other Items:

- Adjustable bar height chair
- Wireless pack for in ears with monitoring in stereo.

Drums:

- 22" kick
- 10" rack
- 14" by 6" snare (metal or wood. spare snare if possible)
- 2 large crashes (18" and up if possible)
- 20" or 22" ride
- 14" hi hats
- China or explosion crash
- 4 symbol stands
- Hi hat stand
- Rug

Drum Brands: Gretsch, Yamaha, Pearl or any quality make

Bass Amp:

- 4x10 cabinet. Ampeg SVT or equivalent (At least 500 watt head) and all cables

Guitar Amp:

- Fender Twin Reverb 65 re-issue amp on tilt back or Mesa Boogie, or equivalent, as long as it has a good clean channel.

Guitar Cables:

- One 25 ft guitar cable, one 10 ft guitar cable, two 8 ft guitar cables, and two 3 inch guitar cables (approx sizes)

2 Acoustic/Electric Guitars:

- Takamine 12 String Acoustic Electric Guitar with Guitar strap and cables
- Takamine 6 string Acoustic Guitar

Electric Guitar:

- Fender Strat Electric Guitar (with no humbuckers) with standard tremolo arm, strap and cables

Guitar Stands:

- 4 guitar stands
- 1 mandolin stand

Microphones:

- **Wireless Lead Vocal Mic-**
1 Shure (SC) wireless SM 58 Microphone or Sennheiser
- 4 wired Vocal Mics

Five Mic Stands:

All Vocal Microphones should be on boom stands please, and one goose neck for drummer with boom.

Six DI Boxes:

- 1 DI for Mandolin/Acoustic Guitar (I use same wireless/DI pack set up and just switch instruments)
- 1 DI for 12 String Guitar
- 1 DI for Sax wireless
- 1 DI for bass
- 2 DIs Total for Keyboards

Three Wireless Units:

Three Wireless units for Instruments (Sennheiser or equivalent) for:

- Acoustic/Electric Mandolin
- Saxophone
- 12 String Acoustic Electric Guitar

Quarter Inch Cables:

- One 25 ft guitar cable (approx size)

I provide the acoustic/electric Mandolin but I do need guitar cable

Wireless in ear monitor system:

- Sennheiser or equivalent (I can provide my own in ears)
